Meeting Minutes - February 14, 2025

- 1) Bring Meeting to Order Sean brought the meeting to order at 8:05 a.m. In attendance were Sean Bardell, Marie Russo Favatella, Jeb Kegg, Mary Jo Casalena (via phone), Jim Wehling and Jeff Claycomb; Nate Roadman was absent.
- 2) Review and Approve Regular Meeting Minutes from Prior Month Mary Jo moved to approve the minutes and Jeb seconded it. Motion carried.

4) Old Business

- a) <u>SAP & DC Mini-grant</u> bike racks and educational displays were ordered. Have 3 docents; need 6 others. Jim, Mary Jo and Kris Schaale will decide on content. Jim will work on signage and then get back to the group. Jim will contact Faith Price.
- b) Mini-grant Implementation & Fundraising Plan Sold 2 benches & 2 educational displays.
- c) <u>Trail Maintenance</u> -. Jeb will contact Tim Ford about mowing.
- d) <u>Rotary Peace Pole</u> Ceremony is to be held on 3/29. Jim will confirm date and time.
- e) Northern Trail Jeb talked with Bob Salathe who said he did have a Phase 1 done and there were no findings. He probably would lease it or possibly sell it (appraised at ~\$97k). Potential advantages to buying it: has water, sewage for restrooms etc. May be able to receive funding (80/20). Jeb will follow up with Bob to determine potential selling price. Purchase would work better from a grant perspective. Would consider a long term lease (25-30 years).
- f) <u>Marker Update</u> Posts were installed behind the fence this week. Markers will be installed later.
- g) <u>OBV Boat Launch</u> Jim was hoping the leadership class would take it on, but they have other projects. So, he'll approach the rotary club about placing 1-2 loads of stone by bridges, which will allow area for fishermen and kayakers, then it could be mowed.
- h) <u>Trail Video</u> Need to place it on FaceBook (FB) so it can be shared. Jim will contact Keith Landis about the link.
- Dam Removal from American Rivers Jim said it's moving forward; American Rivers presented to council. They have funding, which could be available as soon as this summer or next summer at latest.

- b) Possible Mountain Bike Project We need to hike it, pending weather. Sean will send out Doodle Poll.
- c) <u>Recognition of Founding Members</u> Sean looked into native stone with a bronze plaque. They are precast, easy to put up and last a long time; grout is made for outdoors. Best place is at the trailhead by Omni Bedford Springs. Lead time is less than one week.
